

Roles Of Involved Institutions

Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh

- -The RCPE will provide for MRCP UK curriculum. Assist in quality control and provide e-portfolios for the trainees.
- -It will sponsor trainees to take up a job in the UK after completion of 2 years training in Kyrgyzstan and having passed MRCP part 1.

ISM EDUTECH:

- -ISM will be the lead organization for 2+2 Programme in Kyrgyzstan and will take responsibility to liaise between BAPIO Training Academy and the respective Kyrgyz institutes where the 2 years training for the above program will be imparted.
- -ISM will responsible for shortlisting and deployment of trainees at Kyrgyz Institutes.

IHSM & International Accredited Hospital

- IHSM & its International accredited hospitals (In Kyrgyzstan) will be responsible for the first 2 years of training for 2+2 Programme in Kyrgyzstan
- -IHSM & the affiliated hospitals will ensure the local faculty provides training to enrolled students as per the MRCP curriculum and update the same regularly to BTA academic quality team.
- -They will liaise with ISM, USW and BTA in UK and co-ordinate the annual visits of UK training faculty.

University of South Wales

- This University will be UK organization participating in delivering MBA training as part of this programme.

Roles of Involved Institutions

BAPIO Training Academy(BTA)

- -BTA will co-ordinate this programme and work as a link between Kyrgyzstan and the UK.
- -It will also be responsible for creating the UK visiting faculty and the UKJ consortium of General Hospitals.
- -It will co-ordinate with the faculty visit to Kyrgyzstan organize UK induction and mentoring .
- -It will provide pastoral care to ensure the well-being of trainee doctors whilst in the UK.
- -It is anticipated that 2 UK trainers will go to Kyrgyzstan for 1 teaching every three months.

Program Quality Assurance

- 360 degree feedback and realtime intervention will be undertaken to safeguard the standard of the 2+2 programme.
- -The programme overseas and in the UK will be closely monitored and audited by experts deputed by the BAPIO Training Academy.

Responsibilities of the UK Trusts

- Sign contract with the BAPIO Training Academy
- Full support for planned education and training

Finances

- Eligible graduate doctors are expected to pay a yearly fee of 16,000 GBP whilst in the Kyrgyzstan for first 2 years part of the programme
- While in UK for the next 2 years of the program the doctors will be paid a salary commensurate with the NHS pay band (Avg. 35,000 GBP per annum gross salary)
